

ORDINANCE 2015 - 8

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BROKEN BOW, NEBRASKA ADOPTING SECTION 72-16 IN THE BROKEN BOW MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PARKING OF DETACHED TRUCK, ETC., TRAILERS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING A TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROKEN BOW CITY, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1: That Section 72.16 of the Broken Bow Municipal Code be adopted to read as follows:

(A) *It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of a truck trailer, utility trailer, boat trailer, horse trailer, or other trailers designed to be pulled behind a motor vehicle, to park such trailer detached from its motor vehicle on the streets in the business or residential district of the City, only then for a period of no longer than eight (8) hours, except in specifically designated areas; provided, the location of the detached trailer does not impede the safe flow of traffic.*

(B) *A temporary permit may be obtained by a contractor with a current zoning permit for an unattached trailer to be parked on the streets in front of a business or residential property for a limited time as established by the Zoning Administrator or City Administrator. A placard issued by the Zoning Administrator or City Administrator showing the address of the permit, issuance date, and expiration date shall be attached to the trailer visible from the traffic side.*

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
