Preferred qualifications include certified applicators license through Nebraska HHS, 1 year experience in the operation, maintenance and safety precautions involved in the operation of street equipment, and knowledge of materials and equipment used in construction and maintenance of city streets.

**Role and Responsibilities**

- Safely operates trucks, rollers, front-end loaders, tractors, power mowers, chip machines, chain saws, sprayers, motor grader, snow blower, street sweeper, and other equipment.
- Maintains department equipment and buildings.
- Installs and repairs fences.
- Erects signs.
- Cleans culverts.
- Removes snow.
- Maintains streets.
- Operates department equipment safety.
- Performs mowing and trimming and other related duties.
- Trims and removes trees.
- Assists other departments as required.
- Performs other work related duties as assigned.

**Qualifications and Education Requirements**

- High School Diploma or Equivalent.
- Commercial Drivers License.
- Certified Applicators License through Nebraska HHS.
- One year experience in the operation, maintenance and safety precautions involved in the operation of street equipment.
- Knowledge of materials and equipment used in construction and maintenance of city streets.
- Strong verbal, written and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to operate mobile equipment such as trucks, cranes, loaders, backhoe, and tractors.
- Ability to operate machines and use hand tools do to work of a non-repetitive nature such as mechanics and carpentry.

**Working Conditions:**

- This position is subject to both environmental conditions which include extreme heat and cold.
- Very heavy work; exerting in excess of 100 pounds of force occasionally, and/or in excess of 50 pounds of force frequently; and/or in excess of 20 pounds of force constantly to move objects.
